Get Ready For Your Junk Journal-Making Class

I imagine it full of stories, scraps, and little pieces of soul stitched together with glitter and glue.

Imagine it for your junk journal...

Now, before you get concerned about the name Junk Journal, a traditional junk journal is made out of 'junk'. Old letters, cards, t-shirts, stamps, and scraps of paper and wrapping paper.

Some people save it, some people toss it. Some people use it because they are "keeping memories alive in the most beautiful of ways."

What I bring

I will bring the basics - cutting tools and glue, paper (oh my, I have a lot of types, styles, and themes of paper). I have ephemera (that means all the cut things that make your journal interesting). I have a variety of journal bases (notebooks - spirals, 3-ring journals, vintage books, more modern books (still old ones - like from the 80 - 90's), book covers to fill in with your 'papers'. Cardstock, cardboard, black cardstock, brown cardstock for covers. Embellishments - ribbon, lace, fabric, mohair yarn, buttons, beads, shaped and themed cutouts, markers, watercolor paints, charms, a variety of themed stickers (floral, people, words, animals, space, travel, etc), washi tape, and I may not have gone through half of what I will bring. I will have items for the following styles - shabby chic, vintage, bohemian, cottage core, farm themed, travel, French, and more. I have junk journals that are pre-printed, where you cut them out and put them together (I will bring a sample for you to see how to make it).

I will also bring à la carte items for purchase. These are small items that you can add to your journal - loaded pockets, folios, pens and pen holders, page holders (magnets), bookmarks, loaded envelopes, loaded tags, note pads, and other must-have items for your journal.

What You Need To Bring

- ~ Bring photos (old or new)
- ~ Going back in time - Ticket stubs - now you have a place for them and anything else that brings memories alive for you.
- ~ Menus from your favorite restaurants, wedding menu, or any little thing that matters, like matchbooks and napkins
- ~ Lace and ribbons from special outfits from the past, buttons, belt buckles, anything that will make your journal yours.
- ~ Fabric from a homemade quilt, you still have squares, from your favorite t-shirts, blue jeans, fabric on a journal, just adds stories, interest, and everything your journal needs.
- ~ Jewelry, buttons, and other bits and bobs.
